

# Campaign Backgrounder

*Smile, California* is the Medi-Cal Dental Program promotional campaign, created to educate over 14 million members about their covered dental services, how to access care and the important relationship between their oral health and their overall health. The campaign also aims to increase provider enrollment in the program.

## CAMPAIGN OBJECTIVE

*Smile, California* is part of an integrated member and provider outreach plan developed by the Department of Health Care Services. The campaign helps meet the following objectives:

**Increase the number of annual dental visits by all members**

**Increase the number of children ages six to nine receiving molar sealants**

**Increase the number of dentists who accept Medi-Cal and accept new Medi-Cal patients**

### First Tooth, First Birthday, First Visit

Schedule your child's first dental visit as soon as their first tooth comes in or by their first birthday, whichever comes first.

### Seal Today to Prevent Decay

Sealants are protective coatings put on back teeth to help prevent cavities and keep them healthy. Sealants are part of your child's Medi-Cal dental benefit and can protect their back teeth for several years.

### Healthy Children Are Ready to Learn!

Poor oral health can affect a child's attendance, grades and overall performance in school. Seeing a dentist every six months is the best way to ensure a child remains pain-free and able to focus in school.

### A Healthy Smile Never Gets Old
