Speaker: Narrator- If your Medi-Cal dentist provides teledentistry services, they may offer to schedule a video appointment.

Speaker: Narrator- There may also be some new changes when you visit your dental office to keep you safe. For example:

Speaker: Narrator- You may have fewer appointment options to minimize patient-to-patient contact.

Speaker: Narrator- You may also be required to wear a face mask in the office...

Speaker: Narrator- ...and have your temperature taken and be asked screening questions before you can see the dentist.

Speaker: Narrator- You may be asked to sanitize your hands as soon as you enter the office...

Speaker: Narrator- ...be required to wait outside of the dental office, or...

Speaker: Narrator- ...be expected to maintain social distancing in the waiting room.

Speaker: Narrator- You may ask your dental office about requirements when scheduling an appointment.
